

What Is Modeling?

It is a way to teach language and effective use of AAC in natural interactions using the student's speech-generating device.

A communication partner doesn't need to model every word. Instead, focus on core words and other high impact words.



Why Is Modeling Important?

Language development requires repeated exposure to words.

Modeling is essential for students to learn the meaning behind the words in their speech-generating device. This allows them to authentically communicate.

Implementing Modeling

Point to 1-2 key words on the speechgenerating device while speaking a sentence aloud.

A communication partner may say "I like this book" while pointing to the words I + like on the student's device.



Tips for Effective Modeling

To get the most impact out of modeling:

- Model often + naturally
- Model all communication functions
- Slow down and provide time for the student to engage if they wish
