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What is a Smart Chart?

A smart chart is a page of symbol sequences used in the speech-generating device or app.

It is a visual tool that assists the person talking with the AAC user to locate target words for a lesson.

Using a Smart Chart

Follow the symbol sequences in the speech-generating device or app to learn how to say the word.

Notice the predictable pattern used to say similar groups of words.

Shark WATER ANIMALS	
Whale WITE AND WAS WITE AND WAS WAS A WAS	
Squid WITER MINULES MANUEL SQUID	
Fish WITE ANNUAL TO THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPER	

Storing Smart Charts

Keep smart charts with thematic units. Never cut up a smart chart and attach the symbols directly to pages in a book. This can interfere with literacy development.
