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Helpful Hints to Use This Book

There are many activities and games available for print in the PRC-Saltillo Book of Imagination. There are also carryover activities that may require other materials to make.

To make the book smaller and more manageable, you will want to print many pages double-sided. Others will need to be printed only on one side. Most of the Chapters (i.e., the months), you will want to print double-sided. Most of the activities will be printed single-sided, but not always!





Monster Slime

1/2 cup water
1/2 tsp baking soda
1 tbsp saline solution
1 container
food coloring (optional)

First, add glue and then water to your container and mix well. Add your food coloring (if using it). Add the baking soda and stir. Finally, stir in the saline solution. Keep stirring and kneading until it is not sticky. Then play!

To make it monster slime, add in googly eyes, teeth, and anything else you can think of. Make teeth from foam sheets or cardboard. Make eyes from cardboard and paint them fun colors. Add in bugs or whatever else will be fun!
