If you want to cut out symbols sequences and add them to books so you client can "read" the words, all you need do is print out on some sticker paper.

This folder contains each monthly word list as TXT files, which means you can import them straight into you device and use them with the Vocabulary Builder feature! All PRC Accent devices have this feature and most other PRC devices do, too.
