Model It on the AAC System

Modeling on your child's AAC system is just "talking" using his/her language! When you say a word with your voice, also say it using your child's voice. Take time to learn about the organization of your child's language. Use Word Finder, a helpful tool, to remember where to find words.

Tips to Engage, Expand, and Succeed:

- Stategically create communication opportunities by engineering the environment.
 - Place the toy slightly out of reach or hide it from the communicator. Model phrases, such as: "Where is it?"; "Don't see it."; "Let's look for it."
 - Wind up the toy and don't let go of it right away to encourage spontaneous communication. Use expectant facial expressions and open-ended questions, like: "What should I do?"; or "What's next?"
- Make it a race! Invite the communicator's friends and/or siblings to join the fun. See whose wind-up toy goes further or reaches a specified destination first.
 - Model phrases, like: "Ready, set, go!"; "Let's start."; "Are you ready?"
 - Comment on what happened during the race. Model phrases, like: "It stopped."; "It fell down."; "It went far."; "It was slow."; "It was fast."
- Don't make this feel like work! Focus on using language naturally.




