



Homework Card

Title: Cars

Language Objective: The student will begin to build phrases with 2-3 words.

Instructions: Use this card to reinforce building phrases. Take as long as the student needs to learn. You may want to model language multiple times to help them learn it. By modeling language, you are motivating the student to learn.

Steps:

1. When playing with cars, model possible phrases for your child. Some examples include:
Let's **play cars**
We **need** a car. Do you **want red** or **green? big** or **little, etc.**
Should we go **up** or **down? big** or **little, etc.**
2. Read "Cars Go" book with your student. When reading the book with your student, have him/her read the target words as they appear. Model the use of all the vocabulary in the book.
3. Play Cars Bingo with the family. Have the student begin by listening for a colored car and then identifying it on their game board. They can then call out the phrase on their device before they can put their marker on the square.

Other: Another way you can play is to have students take turns calling out the different colored cards.
