Title: Let's Play Dress Up

Language Objective: The student will express negatives.

Instructions: Use this card to help students play dress up. Have them use their talker to make choices in each activity. You may want to model language multiple times to help them learn it. By modeling language, you are motivating the student to learn.

Steps:

1. Pre-teach the concept of target vocabulary by emphasizing and modeling these core words during routines prior throughout the day when they are getting dressed.

2. Read the book "Do or Don't." Encourage the student to find the words as they appear in the story. Model the words if the student can't find them. You can also hide other vocabulary on their device so only the words for the story are showing.

Encourage your student to talk things they 'want' or 'don't want' throughout the day.

3. Create a Paper Doll Chain with your student. Choose the paper. The length of the chain will depend on the length of the paper. Accordion fold your paper making the folds as wide as you want your doll. The arms of the doll should reach all the way to the edges of the fold. Draw your character. You can make a basic doll shape or experiment. Create a robot, monster or alien. Be sure to include the student in the entire process. Ask them what the 'want' or 'don't want.'

Target Vocabulary includes: do, make, look, put, want, mine, don't, all done, play
