

Dress Up

Unity Sequenced Activity Sets



This activity guide is to be used in conjunction with the Activity Sets found in the most recent version of Unity 60 and 84 Sequenced. Choose activity sets the individual enjoys.

Materials: Multi-colored blocks

Words in Activity Set: See smart charts.

Below are suggestions on how to expose someone to the words in this set. Suggestions for one, two, and three word target phrases are given. As always, show the learner how to find these words (model) as you are interacting. Respond naturally when the words are spoken. This is how he/she will learn what the words mean. For example, say: "Let's **play dress up.**" "I **want** a **red** hat." "What color **do** you **want?**" "Okay. **Put** it on." "I am **all done.**" "How **do** I **look?**" Model words in bold.
