Title: Go Go Redball

Language Objective: The student will use single words to direct actions

Instructions: Use this card while playing with the Go Go Redball app. Take as long as the student needs to learn the skills. You may need to model the language multiple times for them to learn it. By modeling the language, you are motivating the student to learn. Try and talk with core words throughout your day to ensure that the vocabulary is learned.

Steps:

- 1. Watch the Go, Go Redball on YouTube. Talk to your student about how to play the game.
- 2. Play "Go Go Red Ball" on the iPad. Using the target vocabulary, direct the student to make the ball "go," "go more," "stop," etc. Model longer phrases such as "red ball go" or "red ball stop."
- 3. Play again, but this time ask them to tell you what to do. Ask them to try using two words together to make a phrase like you did in the above activity.

Other:

Read the book Mirabelle and the Bouncy Red Ball by Michael Muller. Have the student use their device to say the target words as they appear in the story.
