Homework Card

Title: Lola the Lion

Language Objective: The student will learn to use past tense regular verbs

Instructions: Use this card with the book "Lola the Lion". Take as long as the student needs to learn the skills. You may need to model the language multiple times for them to learn it. By modeling the language, you are motivating the student to learn.

Steps:

- 1. Model and prompt the verbs ending in -ed on the device. Model using them in simple sentences. Have the student practice making up sentences verbs ending in -ed.
- 2. Help the student write a story using past tense verbs ending in -ed. Find pictures in magazines or on the internet to illustrate the story.
- 3. Find other books containing past tense verbs in sentences. Read the books together. Ask the student to say the correct past tense verbs when you come to them.

Other:

Read the book "Lola the Lion" with the student. Have them read the past tense verbs. The next time, have them read as much of the text as they can.
