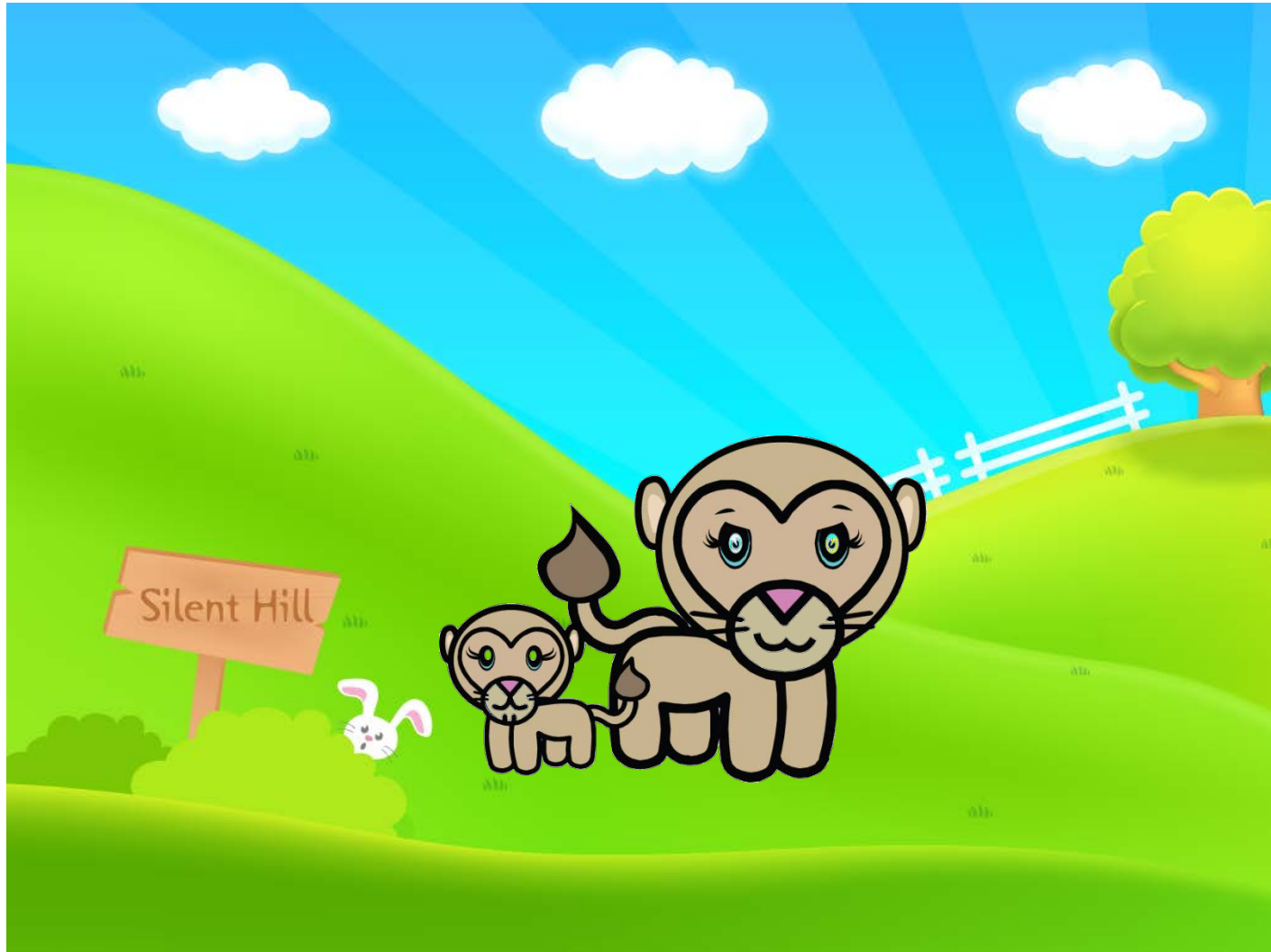
# Instructions

- Ask the person to find and say some other past tense verbs

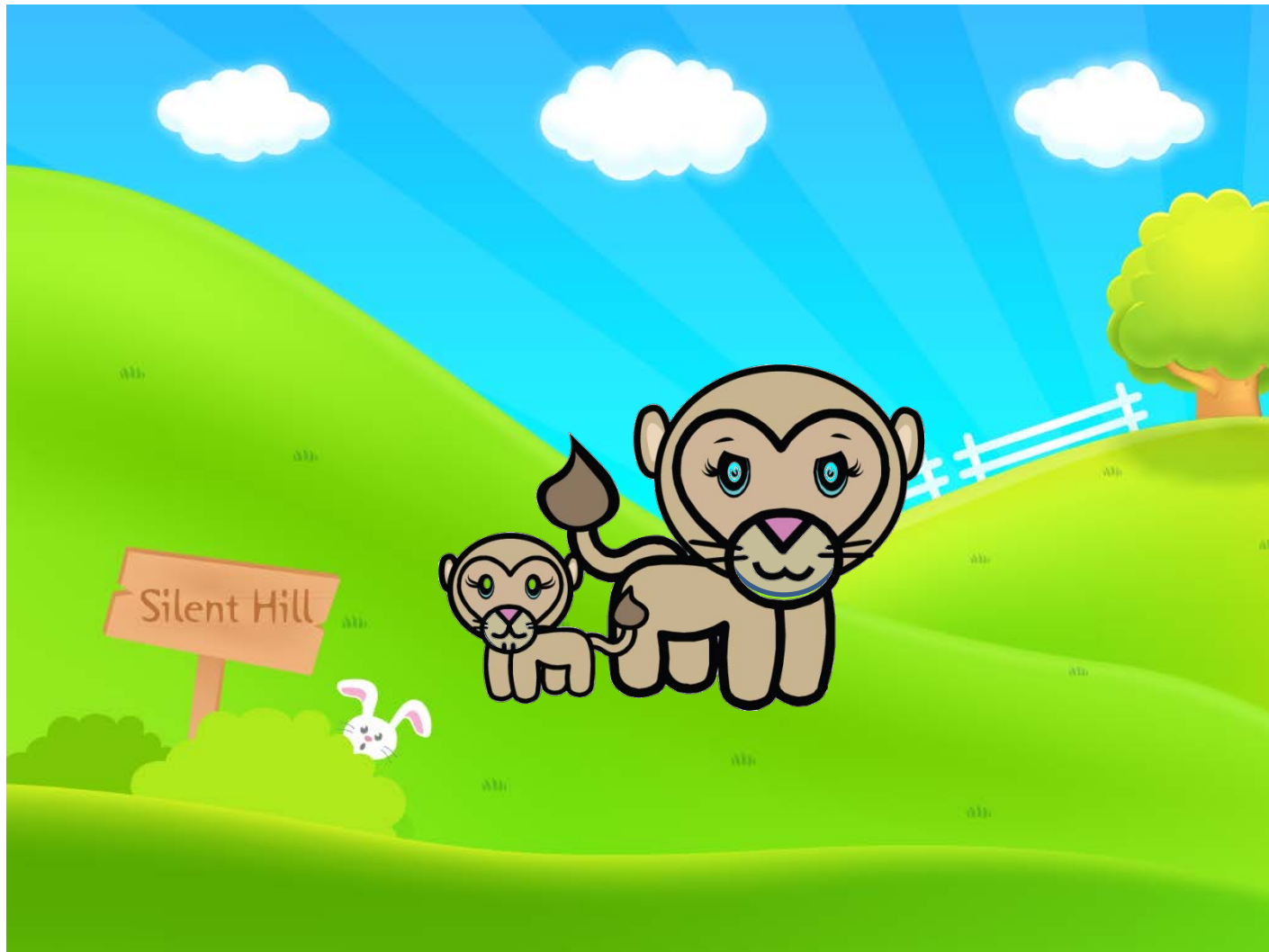
Her name is Lola. She is a lion. She is the daughter of a king.

There was a big rock in their path so Lola's mother said "help me." Lola worked hard and helped her mother move the rock.



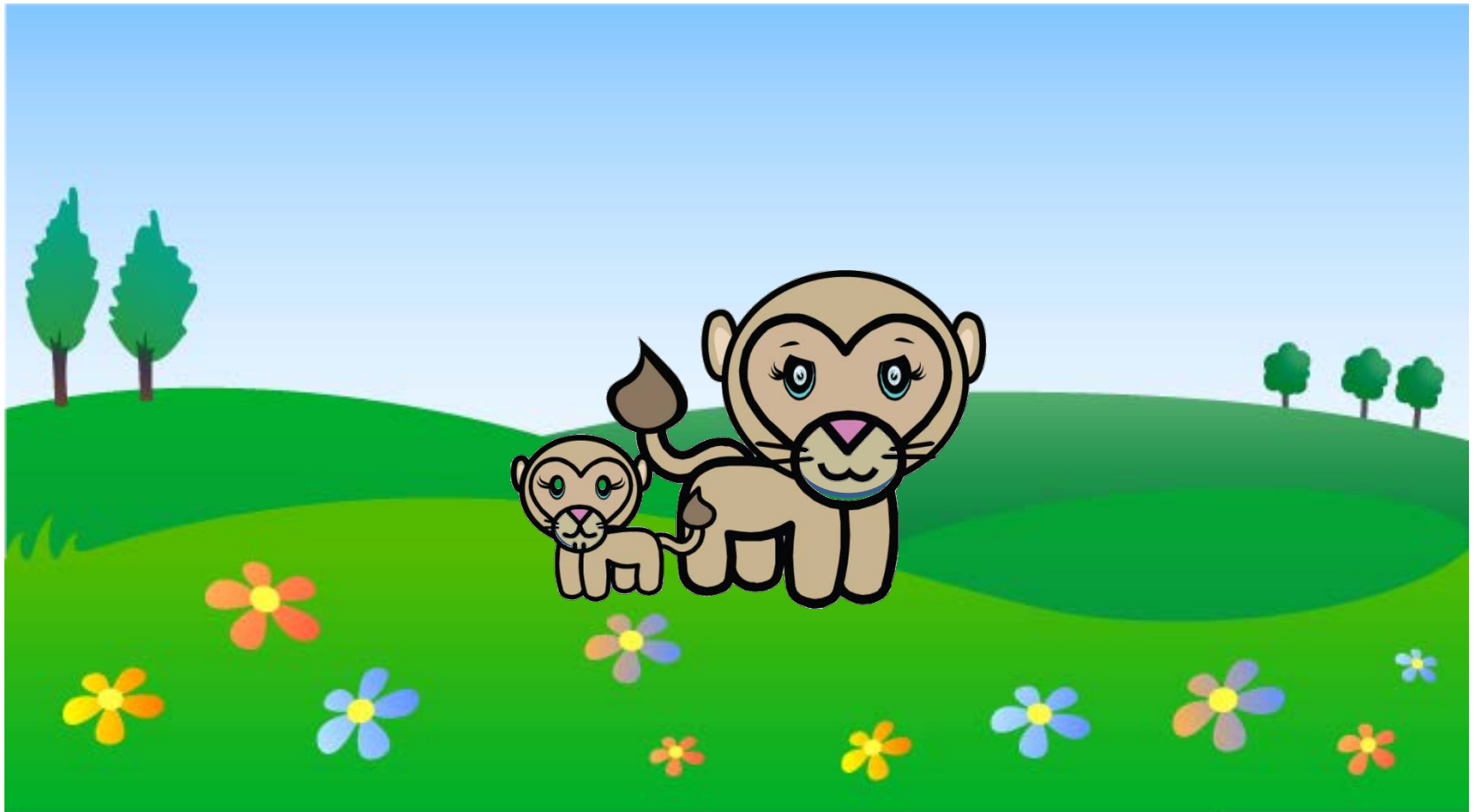

\_\_\_\_\_ for a water hole.”





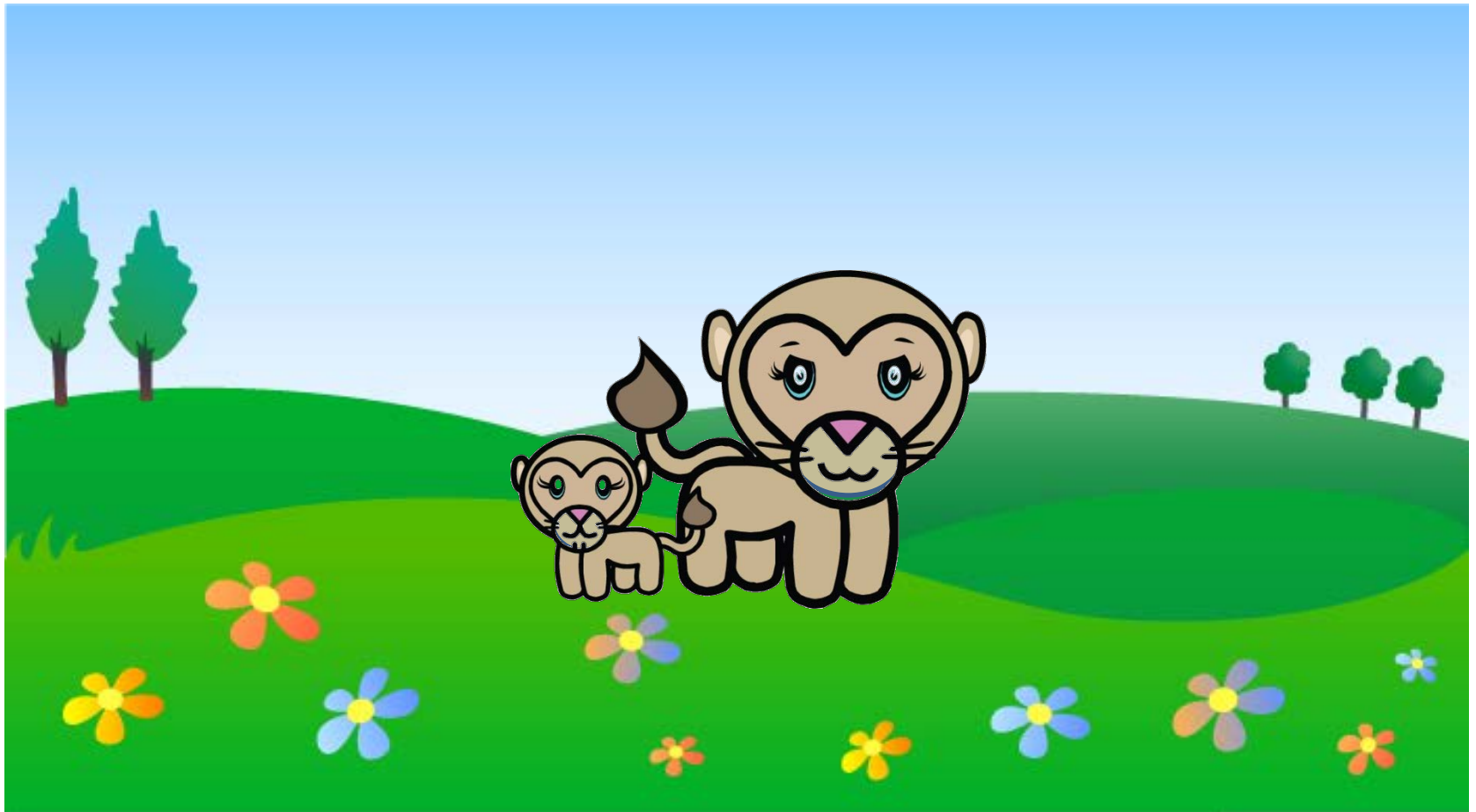
“Then, I \_\_\_\_\_ to mother roar
