


ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	OBJ	Giving – the icon shows someone giving a present – you can give an example, give service, etc.
	POSS (possessive1)	POSSESSIVES= “this bag is MINE”. Writing related words. You can write, print, or copy your name and address on the label. We put labels on mail to send and receive
	SENTENCE	The man and lady are speaking to each other in whole SENTENCES.
	HELPING VERBS	Helping verbs, or auxiliary verbs, are found here. Ex: should, could, would, will, etc.
	INTERJECTION	INTERJECTIONS are words that pop up in conversations like fireworks.










	WIZARD	Mr. WIZARD is pointing to <u>that</u> . DETERMINERS are found here (this, that, these, those, etc.)
ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	CONJUNCTION	The train cars are joined together. CONJUNCTIONS join words together.
	PREP	The PREPOSITION icon is a bridge. The cloud is above the bridge, cars go over the bridge, water goes under the bridge.
? word	QUESTION WORD	The QUESTION WORD icon represents question words.
	NOUN	The NOUN icon is a picture of Mother Hubbard. She is a person, her cupboard is a place, and there is a thing in the cupboard.
	PLURAL	The NOUN PLURAL icon is a picture of Mother Hubbard. She is a person, her cupboard is a place. There are many things in the cupboard.
	ADVERB	Many ADVERBS end in -ly.
	I (I MALE)	The I pronoun icon is a picture of a person pointing to himself.
	WE	The two friends represent the pronoun WE.










	VERB	Mr. Action man represents VERBs .
	VERB+S	The VERB + S icon is the ending key for present tense singular verbs.
ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	VERB+ING	The VERB + ING icon is the ending key for present participles ending in -ing.
	VERB+ED	The VERB + ED icon is the ending key for simple past tense verbs.
	VERB+EN	The VERB + EN icon is the ending key for future perfect and past perfect verbs.
	TO+VERB	The VERB + TO icon is the ending key for infinitives.
KEYBOARD 	KEYBOARD	ADJECTIVE + KEYBOARD = link to keyboard page; ending key for describing words.
	ADJ+ER	ADJ + ER = ending key for comparative adjectives; quick access to the word "an".
	ADJ+EST	ADJ + EST = ending key for superlative adjectives; quick access to the word "the".





	MAP	Places (large outdoor places), directions, The island represents a country. Countries have culture, politics, military, etc.
	YOU	The finger is pointing to YOU.
	THEY	THEY are a group.
ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	SCHOOL	School related words. If a teacher asks a question, you raise your hand if you KNOW the answer.
	DICE	You can play games with DICE. Words related to small in size – dice are small.
	SUN	Everybody likes a SUNny day. The SUN is smiling and happy. Jokes and fun related words.
	HAMMER+ N	A carpenter works with a HAMMER. Work related words – many people use tools when they work.
	MONEY (money1)	It's good to have MONEY. Money related words.
	MASKS	The MASKS icon stands for feelings. One is happy and one is sad. Theatre related words (wearing masks while acting)

	BOOK (book1)	Reading related words. Reading BOOKs makes you smart and wise.
	MORE	The hands are signing "more." Most people want to hear MORE MUSIC . Music related words
	SHOE	We wear SHOE s when we run. Sports and exercise related words (whole body movements)
	STOP	Always STOP at the STOP sign.
ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	IT	Mary had a little lamb, IT s fleece was white as snow.
	HE	HE is the he pronoun.
	WANT	The boy WANT s a cookie. Wanting related words – want that 'thing', want a favor or a chance.
	FAMILY	FAMILY represents words about the family. People related words.
	DOG (dog3)	We tell DOG s to COME . Animal related words

	WATCH	Time related words.
	REMEMBE	Tie a string around your finger so that you will REMEMBER to DO something. Things you do with your hands How things feel to touch
	THINK	She is THINKing of a BRIGHT IDEA . THINKing related words.
	ELEPH	ELEPHANTs are BIG . Things elephants can do; words related to big and powerful.
	MORNING (morning3)	We get up in the MORNING . The mountains represent places in nature.
ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	RAINB	A RAINBOW is made up of many colors. Colors and art, words that describe art.
	BATH	Bathroom words – hair, make-up, manicure, etc. Body words – the boy is washing his body in the BATH . Sensory words – relate to the body.
	SHE	SHE is the she pronoun.
	EYE	We LOOK each other in the EYEs . Vision and looking related words

	SNAIL	The SNAIL moves SLOWly .
	LAPTOP	Computer words.
	iPhone	The PHONE icon shows a phone. Communication words.
	THUMB UP	The THUMBS UP icon represents positive words.
	EAR	We listen with our EARS . Hearing and sound related words
ICON	ICON NAME	RATIONALE
	HOUSE (HOUSE9)	The HOUSE icon represents building and home-related words. House related words – things you do around the house.
	GO	GOing and hurrying – you can GO places in the community.
	TRUCK	The TRUCK represents all types of vehicles.
	LOVE	The mom LOVEs her baby. Love related words.

	<p>AMBULANCE</p>	<p>We call an AMBULANCE when we need HELP.</p> <p>Medical words.</p>
<p>CLEAR</p> 	<p>CLEAR</p>	<p>BLANK = Clear Display</p>
	<p>NOT</p> <p>(NEWNOT1)</p>	<p>NOT represents negative words.</p>
	<p>SUIT</p>	<p>SUIT represents clothing words. You WEAR a SUIT.</p>
	<p>APPLE</p>	<p>You can eat an APPLE. The APPLE icon represents food and eating words.</p>
	<p>GOD</p> <p>(god3)</p>	<p>People make cookies of various shapes to celebrate holidays. Many holidays have a religious (GOD) meaning.</p>
<p>ICON</p>	<p>ICON NAME</p>	<p>RATIONALE</p>
	<p>UMBRELLA</p>	<p>You need an UMBRELLA when it rains.</p> <p>Weather words.</p>
	<p>THUMB DOWN</p>	<p>The THUMBS DOWN icon on the handle represents negative words.</p>
	<p>TV</p> <p>(FLATTV4)</p>	<p>TV and Movie words – many people on TV are famous. When you watch a movie, expected and unexpected things happen.</p>

	<p>JUICE</p> <p>(CANGL)</p>	<p>DRINK related words</p> <p>Things you can do with a straw (blow, suck) or a glass (fill, spill). Soda can explode.</p>
	<p>KITCHEN</p> <p>(POT1)</p>	<p>Turn the spoon around in the KITCHEN pan the food can cook. This icon represents kitchen and temperature -related words, also the word turn.</p>
	<p>CHEST</p> <p>(open1)</p>	<p>You can PUT things into the open CHEST.</p>
	<p>BED</p>	<p>You sleep in a BED.</p>
