Homework Card

Title: We Are Home

Language Objective: The student will speak using single words.

Instructions: Use this card to help students talk about a time when they were scared or sick. Take as long as the student needs to learn. You may want to model language multiple times to help them learn it. By modeling language, you are motivating the student to learn.

Steps:

- 1. Pre-teach the concept of target vocabulary by emphasizing and modeling these core words during routines prior to the introduction of the book or activity. Talk about current events and ask the person to share how they feel.
- Read the book "We Are Home." Encourage the student to find the words as they 2. appear in the story. Model the words if the student can't find them. You can also hide other vocabulary on their device so only the words for the story are showing.
 - Encourage your student to talk about how they feel throughout the story. Give them time to express whatever is on their mind.
- 3. Use the writing template so the student can express their different feelings. What makes them feel that way? They can write with single words, phrases, or more. You may need to explain what the emoticons represent or let them determine for themselves.

Other: Use the included Choice Board to help your student make decisions about what activities they would like to do. Have them use their device to tell you what they choose. You can also talk about things they "like" and "don't like." Change the board to include things important to your student.

Target Vocabulary includes: feel, sick, good, bad, far, away, wash, don't, help, need, close, touch
