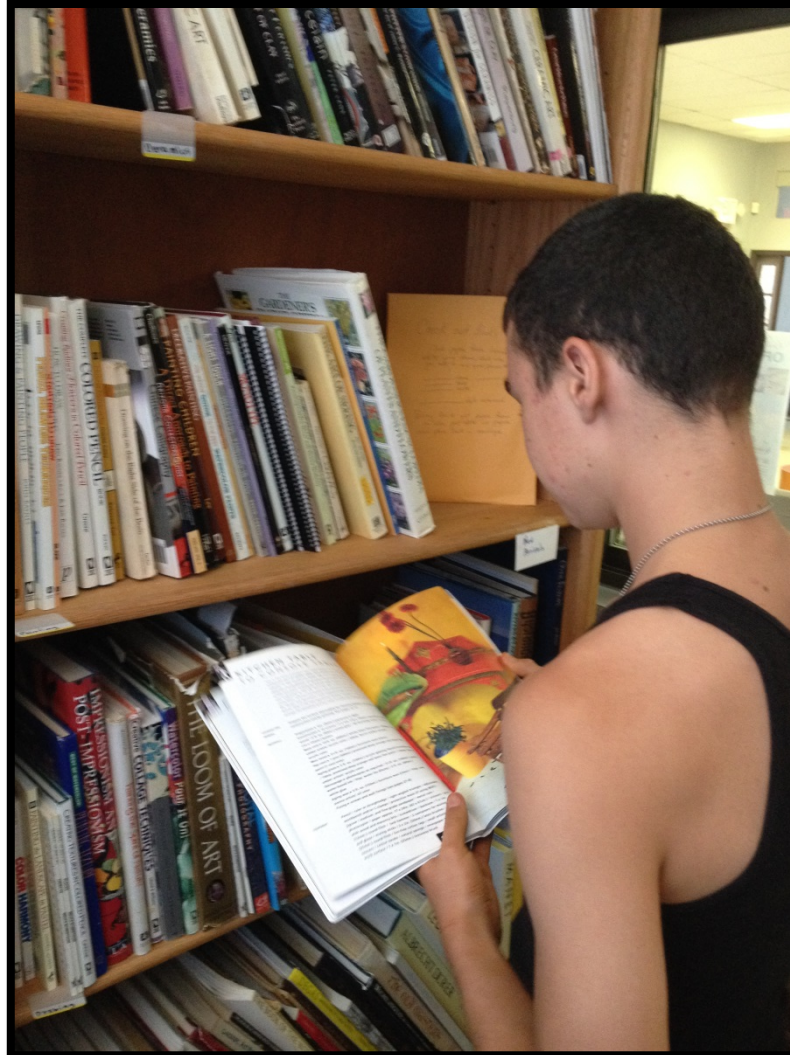

When he saw something he liked, he looked very closely.



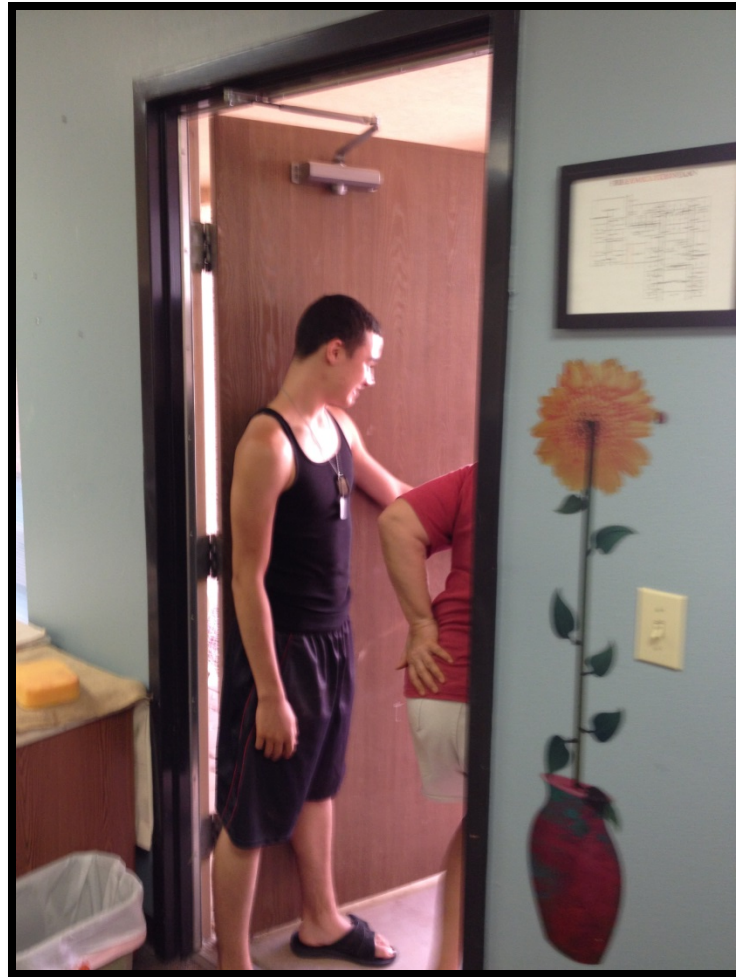
Chase listened as an artist explained what she was doing with clay.



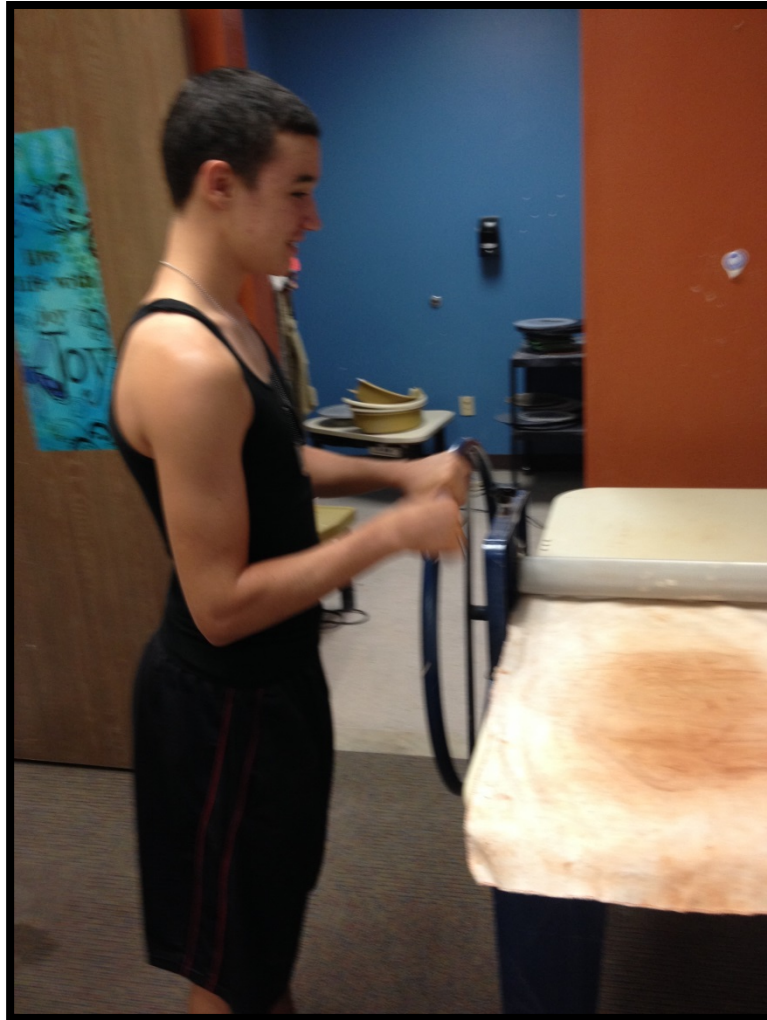
He worked on some of the clay pieces too!
